## HOMEWORK PACKETS

- PCSC teachers have prepared eLearning assignments that include paper components, so all work can be completed with zero or minimum time on the internet.
- All Elementary and Middle School Students received packets from their teacher. HS Students only received a packet if requested. All HS assignments are also available through Google Classroom
- A district-wide pick-up date was held on April 3, 2020. No additional pick up dates are scheduled.
- Please contact your teacher or building principal if you have questions or were not able to pick up your homework packet.

## RETURNING WORK TO YOUR TEACHER

- For assignments you can complete online: if you have access and have been instructed to use specific methods to turn your work in, you will continue to follow those instructions.
- Many students are using cell phones to take a photo of paper assignments to email to their teacher.
- If you have paper assignments to return, you have the following options:
  - Each Food Service Location will be collecting homework throughout our closure. You can visit these locations from 11-1 on Monday, Wednesday, or Friday to return your work.
  - A large envelope for returning your work was included with your Homework Packet (Winslow=Yellow, Red=Petersburg, Gray=Middle School, White=High School).
  - Contact your school's office if you did not receive enough return envelopes.
  - Write your grade and teacher on the envelope and place it in a designated drop box. The drop boxes are located at the front entrance of Petersburg Elementary and Winslow Elementary, or at the back entrance to Pike Central (PC Commons area).
  - To maintain safety, the returned items will be sanitized and stored for a period of time. Your teacher(s) will then pick these items up to begin reviewing, grading, and contacting students and parents about any concerns.
    - Please contact your teacher or building principal if you have questions or concerns about turning in your eLearning assignments.



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## ADDITIONAL STUDENT INFORMATION:

- Assignments must be completed and returned in order to record attendance for eLearning
- Students will be provided an opportunity to remove all personal items from their lockers at a later date. Depending on recommended guidelines, students may be limited to the number allowed in at one time. More information will be provided as the plan is developed.
- All required testing for the Spring of 2020 has been cancelled by the Indiana Department of Education. This cancellation includes: IREAD-3, ILEARN, ISTEP+, IAM, ISPROUT.
- Pike Central High School will NOT be giving Final Exams at the conclusion of the 2019-20 school year. The Semester 2 grade calculation will be: 50% Grading Period 3 and 50% Grading Period 4.
- **Food Service will continue throughout the closure of PCSC schools.**
